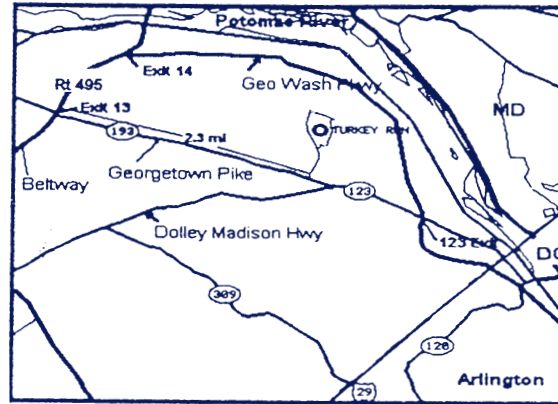

## Directions to the Pavilions of Turkey Run



### *FROM THE WASHINGTON BELTWAY:*

Take VA Rte. 193 (Georgetown Pike) East towards Langley. Drive 2.3 miles and turn left onto Colonial Farm Rd.— just prior to junction with Rt. 123. Follow signs to The Pavilions of Turkey Run.

### *FROM WASHINGTON, DC:*

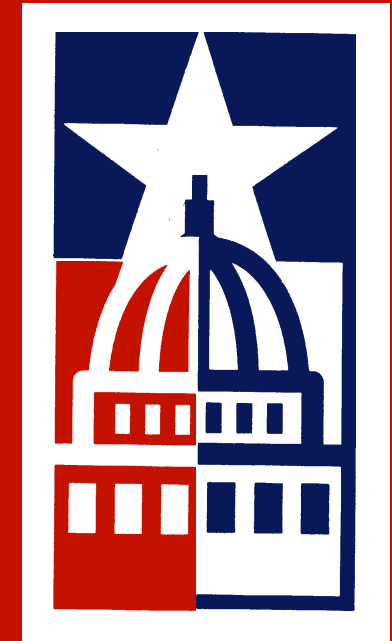
Take George Washington Parkway North to Rte. 123 exit toward McLean. Drive almost 1 mile and turn right onto Rte. 193. Make the first right onto Colonial Farm Rd. Follow signs to The Pavilions of Turkey Run.

### *FROM TYSONS CORNER:*

Take Rte. 123 North for about 4 miles. Turn left onto Rte. 193. Make the first right onto Colonial Farm Rd. Follow signs to The Pavilions of Turkey Run.
