## Directions to Fort Hunt Park

Fort Hunt Park is located along the George Washington Memorial Parkway in Fairfax County, Virginia.

*From Downtown Washington, DC:*

take I4th Street Bridge south towards Virginia. Take exit for Mount Vernon/National Airport; this puts you on the George Washington Memorial Parkway southbound; continue past National Airport, through Old Town Alexandria (for two miles, the Parkway becomes Washington Street through Old Town; when, you reach the city limits, you are back on the Parkway); Fort Hunt Park is 5 miles south of Old Town Alexandria; exit to the right at the sign marked "Fort Hunt Road/Fort Hunt Park".

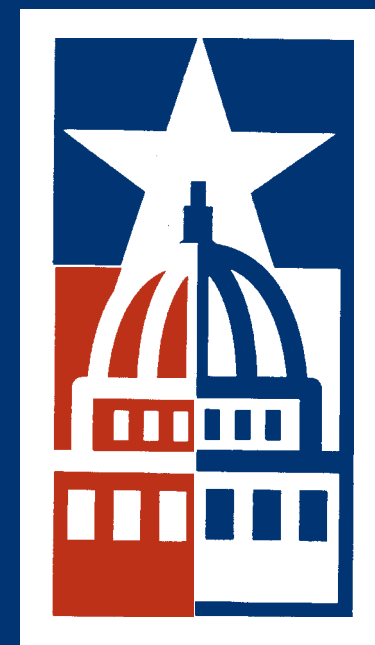
